Materials Required

1 skein of Medium Worsted Weight Yarn (Category 4)
5.5mm/I9 Crochet Hook

Craft Scissors
Yarn Needle

Head Circumference Measurements 22 inches $/ 56 \mathrm{cms}$
Skill Level: Easy

## Stitches \& Terms

BPdc = Back Post double crochet
ch = chain
ch-2 $=2$ chain stitches previously made at start of the round
dc = double crochet
FPdc = Front Post double crochet
rep = repeat
sl st = slip stitch
$\mathrm{sp}=$ space
st = stitch
sts $=$ stitches

Written Pattern: (last updated $2 / 21 / 14$ )
ch 5 , sl st into first ch st to form ring. (5 ch sts)
Round 1: Ch 2, (work over yarn tail) 10 dc into ring, join with a sl st into top of ch-2. (11 dc)

Pull center yarn tail to tighten.
Round 2: Ch 2, 1 dc into same st as ch-2, 2 dc into each dc around to the end, join with a sl st into top of ch-2. (22 dc)
Round 3: Ch 2, * 2 dc into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, rep from * around to the last st, 2 dc into last st, join with sl st into top of ch-2. (33 dc)
Round 4: Ch 2, * 2 dc into next dc, 1 dc into each of next 2 dc , rep from * around to the last 2 sts, 2 dc into next st, 1 dc into last st, join with sl st into top of ch-2. ( 44 dc )
Round 5: Ch 2, * 2 dc into next dc, 1 dc into each of next 3 dc , rep from * around to the last $3 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into the next st, 1 dc into each of the next 2 sts , join with sl st into top of ch-2. (55 dc)
Round 6: Ch 2, * 2 dc into next dc, 1 dc into each of next 4 dc , rep from * around to the last 4 sts, 2 dc into next st, 1 dc into each of the next 3 sts, join with sl st into top of ch-2. (66 dc)
Rounds 7-9: Ch 2, 1 dc into each dc around to the end, join with a sl st into top of ch-2. (At the end of each of these rounds you should have 66 dc sts.)
Rounds 10-15: Ch 2, * 1 FPdc around each of the next 4 stitches, 1 BPdc around each of the next 4 stitches, rep from * around to the last st, 1 dc into last st, join with a sl st into top of ch-2.
NOTE: If you need assistance with rounds 10-15, please watch the step-by-step video below by Paula Daniele with Crochet Hooks You, for instructions on how to crochet the FPdc \& BPdc stitches.
Round 16: Ch 2, 1 hdc into each st around to the end, join with a sl st into top of ch-2.

Finish off.

Weave in ends with a yarn needle.
