Contents: 12 Sessions plus an introduction and notes for leaders.
Audience: Participants with some Bible study experience who want to explore women included in the Gospels, the Book of Acts and the Book of Philippians.
Comments: Workbook format with space for writing answers to each question.

Title: *Women Who Changed Their World*
Author(s): Jill Briscoe

Date: 1999
Genre: Bible Study
Contents: 8 Sessions, covering nine different Old Testament women. Sessions include leader helps, readings, content questions, digging deeper questions and prayer suggestions.
Audience: Directed to women who have some Bible study experience.
Comments: Contains some New Testament references.
