# EAT YOUR VEGGIES

## WEEK 2: BECAUSE I SAID SO

**Big Idea:** During these difficult times, which we have no experience dealing with, we find ourselves wrestling with who to trust. If we knew who had the most wisdom relevant to our situation, it would be easy. But we don't. Our minds find it almost impossible to sit in the tension of the unknown, so what do we do. As Brene Brown would say, we fill in the gaps of our story so we can complete the narrative even if we fill in the blanks with what may not be true. We lean on our own understanding and fill in the blanks. But Solomon gives his son good advice. He simply says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

### **Application & Reflection:**

1. Name an example of a time you trusted God in the past.
2. What are some resources you currently put your trust in?
3. How may God be asking you to trust him today?

**Prayer:** Lord God, we give You thanks that You are a God we can trust. Help us to seek your wisdom when we're struggling with who to trust or which way to turn. Remind us that You are always there for us and we can always turn to You. Amen.
