WEEK 2: PAUL—NEW EYES

Big Idea: Paul, one of the greatest planters of the church, didn't start out that way. Saul, as he was first known in the Bible, persecuted Christians. He did everything that he could do to destroy the church. But he met Jesus on the road to Damascus - a place he was going to put Christians in prison and his life was never the same. He went from being a man consumed by darkness to someone who spread God's light, from trying to destroy the church, to spreading the good news of Jesus far and wide. You don't have to have a "road to Damascus" story to know that God is an active presence in your life. God can reshape your perspective and help you see even the most difficult times thru a different lens, helping you share His light in the world.

Application & Reflection:

- 1. Name a time in the past when you were heading in one direction but God turned you in another direction.
- 2. How have you felt God's presence during this time of sheltering in place?
- 3. How might God be helping to change your perspective on something?

<u>Prayer:</u> Lord God, we give You thanks for the example of Paul and how his perspective changed on the road to Damascus. Help us to feel Your presence with us and be open to where You're calling us as we listen for Your voice to guide and direct us. Amen.
