WEEK 1: RUTH—NEW FUTURE

Big Idea: One of the more painful parts of these last several months sheltering in place have been when people have lost loved ones and can't grieve together or celebrate their loved one's memory the way they normally would. Death is the ultimate disruption to our lives, yet there are many disruptions in life that leave us feeling as though nothing will ever be the same again. We often feel stuck and unable to move forward. Ruth teaches us how to move into a new future with God's help.
